The following actions occurred and reports were shared at the October 15, 2025, council meeting:

- Set the fall congregation meeting for Sunday, November 16, 2025 directly following 9:00AM worship.
- Approved the proposed 2026 budget to be presented at the November 16, 2025 congregation meeting.
- Approved the following nominations for open council positions: Jay Frey and Kurt Steigerwalt for 3-year terms; Scott Klotz for 2-year term. Nominations will be taken from the floor at the congregation meeting for two 3-year terms and one 1-year term.
- * Regretfully accepted Trell Schleicher's resignation from council and Bridgette Gorman's resignation as music director.
- Approved hiring Colleen Rudelitsch as interim music director through November 2, 2025.
- Council expressed their thanks for the Harvest Home donations received on Sunday, October 12 to support the Community Cupboard Food Pantry.
- Received Frank & Deb Bokan as members of the congregation.
- Approved the purchase of three turkeys in support of the free Thanksgiving meal being offered at Ben Salem UCC in cooperation with St. John's (Mahoning), St. Peter's (Mantzville), and Zion Stone (New Ringgold).
- Approved the purchase of save the date magnets for the 175th Anniversary celebration to be held on Sunday, April 12, 2026.
- Noted that items have been taken the clothing donation box located in the church parking lot. Money received for the clothing donations to the box help support the Community Cupboard Food Pantry. If anyone sees any suspicious activity around the donation bin, please contact the church office or a council member. Thank you!













On October 12, 2025 we bid farewell to Bridgette Gorman as our Music Director after over 9 years of sharing her musical gifts with the congregation.
