### **Profession of Faith**

This year (2025) marks the 1700<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Nicene Creed. Back in the year 325 an ecumenical council met in Nicaea to adopt a creed that would be acceptable throughout the whole church. The major point of discussion was whether or not Jesus was "like God" or Jesus

"was God." Different versions were explored but eventually the council settled on "of one essence (Being) with the Father." Here we are 1700 years later still using the Nicene Creed to confess our faith in God, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit. I think it is amazing that we have this expression of faith that unites us across so many centuries. The number of people that have confessed their faith using this creed is more than I can imagine. People of all walks of life, different ethnicities and races, and countries all around the world; those who may have been best of friends and those who were sworn enemies. But all of them united in the belief that God is present to us as the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

But how many of us really take the time to think about what it is we are saying each time we recite the Nicene Creed. How often have we recited the words from memory during worship without internalizing what it is we say? I know I can be guilty of it. I invite you to reflect upon this statement of faith and what each line means. Are there things you never noticed before? Are you puzzled by any of it? Write down any insights or questions you may have and reach out to me for discussion. I would love it! So that you don't have to find it, here's a copy of the creed:

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father; through him all things were made.

For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven, was incarnate of the Holy Spirit and the virgin Mary and became truly human. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.
